

## COUNTRIES THAT WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR REDUCED 2023 RATES

Institutions and their employees in the following countries will be eligible for reduced rates for ASPT membership and institutional subscriptions to Systematic Botany for the 2023 subscription year. The list includes all lower, lower-middle, and upper-middle economies as determined by the World Bank. The list also includes 26 high-income economies, each with a GNI of less than \$25,000.

The cost for a 2023, Developing Country individual membership (with online access to Systematic Botany) is \$30.00 and a basic institutional subscription to Systematic Botany at the Developing Country rate (online only access, no print copy) is \$90.00.
